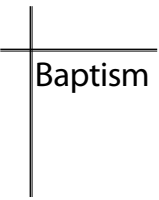

Advent Offering 2017 will support 5 different ministries:

Karodzidzi Primary and Middle School in Ghana: A school that serves several hundred children and is in desperate need of repairs to remain functional. This is the home school of Sam Asmah, FUMCR member and employee.

Project Transformation: A ministry that utilizes the talents of college students in partnership with United Methodist churches to offer daily activities to children in low income neighborhoods.

Network of Community Ministries: An emergency social service agency of Richardson assisting Richardson residents with rental and utility help, as well as providing food pantry and clothing closet items.

Skuinskloof Primary School in South Africa: A ministry of FUMCR. We continue to send work teams to Africa to build and improve facilities at this school.

Go Camp: A North Texas Conference supported camp experience for children in urban and rural communities who may not have access to summer camps. FUMCR will host one of these camps in 2018. It will be an opportunity for children in our community to have a camp experience that otherwise would not have such an opportunity.
