Mike Slaughter

Lead pastor at Ginghamburg Church in Ohio. Mike is the three-decade dreamer of this church and spiritual entrepreneur of ministry marketplace innovations. His life-long passion to reach the lost and set the oppressed free has now made him a tireless and leading advocate for the displaced children, women and men of Darfur, Sudan. Ginghamburg Church has become known as an early innovator of small group ministry, the Church “media reformation” and cyberministry, with the website averaging 50,000 visits monthly from around the world. Clayton Oliphint

Senior pastor of First United Methodist Church Richardson. Clayton began his ministry at a three circuit pastorate in Kansas in 1983. After serving in ministry in the North Texas Conference he was moved to Richardson in 2001. Every church he has served has shown large increases in worship attendance, new members and mission giving. He leads his staff and congregation around the team concept. He is known for his strong leadership at every level in the United Methodist Church and for leadership in the community. Rick speaks across America and around the world, sharing his passion and vision for church planting and leadership.



Chris Hodges

Founder and senior pastor of Church of the Highlands in Alabama. Under his leadership, Church of the Highlands offers 23 worship services each weekend at eight campuses with over 14,000 people attending weekly. Chris Hodges is known for his relevant teaching style, as well as his passion for developing leaders and planting life-giving churches around the world. He co-founded ARC (Association of Related Churches) in 2001 which has planted over 200 churches all across the USA.



Olu Brown

Lead pastor of Impact Church, a new church currently meeting in a middle school in West End Atlanta. Olu is co-author of *Zero to 80: Innovative Ideas for Planting and Accelerating Church Growth*. www.Oto80.org

Rex Miller

Nationally respected futurist, theologian, consultant, speaker and communications expert. He associated himself in recent years with the architectural, engineering and construction industries. Rex believes that the challenges that face these industries are the same threats facing all traditional institutions and industries. Recently Rex joined TAG Consulting as Senior Partner. He is a certified in Core Clarity training and a member of the National Speakers Association. Reggie McNeal

Denominational executive and leadership development coach. He has served as a founding pastor of a new church and been in local congregational leadership for over 20 years. He has lectured as adjunct faculty for multiple seminaries, as well as served as consultant to local churches. Reggie has contributed to numerous publications and church leadership journals. His books include *Revolution in Leadership*; *A Work of Heart: Understanding how God Shapes Spiritual Leaders*; *The Present Future*; *Practicing Greatness*; *Get A Life!*; *Missional Renaissance: Changing the Scorecard for the Church*.

Rusti Moore

Senior pastor of Wildwood United Methodist Church in Magnolia, Texas. Raised a Southern Baptist, it was shocking in 2000 for Rusti to become the first woman elder in the Texas Annual Conference to start a United Methodist Church. 43 visionary people were granted a charter in 2001 and ten years later Rusti preaches to a congregation of 750 congregants who support her vision of being an extension of God's loving hands. Wildwood is known for its numerous hands-on mission ministries. In 2011 the Texas Annual Conference recognized this church as one of three receiving the most professions of faith in the previous year.

Jorge Acevedo

Lead pastor of Grace Church, a multi-site United Methodist congregation in Southwest Florida. This church has grown its weekend attendance from 400 to over 2,600 in the past thirteen years. Grace Church is recognized as having one of the largest and most effective recovery ministries in America with over 800 people involved weekly in recovery ministries. Jorge is co-author of *The Heart of Youth Ministry* and writes extensively for numerous Methodist publications. www.egracechurch.com

Paul Rasmussen

Lead pastor for Cornerstone, the contemporary worship community of Highland Park United Methodist Church in Dallas and preaching pastor for a satellite campus, Munger Place United Methodist Church which opened in 2010. He is a fourth generation Methodist minister, however, his professional career began as a college basketball coach!

Colleen Barrett

President Emeritus of Southwest Airlines Co. Ms. Barrett was a driving force behind Southwest Airlines' renowned customer-focused culture. Originally hired as a corporate secretary in 1978, she was mentored by Herb Kelleher and later held positions of increasing importance: Vice President of Administration, Executive Vice President of Customers and Chief Operating Officer before serving as President from 2001 to 2008.

Ray Hunt

Chairman, President, and CEO of Hunt Consolidated, Inc. Mr. Hunt's association with Hunt Oil Company began in 1958 as a summer employee in the oil fields. After graduating from SMU in 1965 as a Distinguished Scholar with a degree in economics, Hunt joined the family legacy. He has since earned numerous awards for his leadership and innovative impact on the energy industry, service to civic institutions, corporate citizenship and humanitarian efforts.

R. Gerald Turner

President of Southern Methodist University. Mr. Turner is leading an era of unprecedented progress as the University approaches the centennial of its founding in 2011 and of its opening in 2015. Under his leadership, The Second Century Campaign seeks resources for a dramatic increase in academic quality and impact. A new strategic plan guides the University's advancement, and a master plan is reshaping the physical profile of the campus. Southern Methodist University is a private, comprehensive university of 11,000 students enrolled in seven degree-granting schools.
