



Our journey will be a pilgrimage, not a tour or trip.

The difference between a trip or a tour and what we embark upon is the intentional journey that will help you deepen your faith and know God, yourself and your faith in a more personal way.

Fr. Richard Rohr defines *pilgrimage* as an interior journey enacted exteriorly. He points to the idea that pilgrims move in two directions at the same time—an outward direction toward a holy destination and an inward journey seeking an encounter with the sacred.

During our time together, we will learn, see, smell, touch, taste, hear and stand in a way that will broaden your perspective and deepen your faith. 

ITINERARY SUMMARY

Day 1: Depart

Depart Dallas on an overnight flight to Tel Aviv.

Day 2: Arrive in Israel

As soon as we arrive we begin our pilgrimage! We stop at Jaffa on our way to dinner and overnight in Netanya.





Day 3: Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Jezreel Valley, Mt. Arbel, Nazareth

We start the day on the coast at the spectacular site of Caesarea Maritima, then we'll make our way north up to and over Mt. Carmel. We will cross the Jezreel Valley and go up to

Mt. Arbel overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight will be at our hotel in Tiberias, right on the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4: Sea of Galilee, Ginossar, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha

We begin with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, docking at Ginossar to see a boat that dates from Jesus' time. We continue to Capernaum and then to the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes. After lunch of St. Peter's fish, on to Tabgha, traditionally associated with Jesus' multiplication of the loaves and fish. Overnight in Tiberias.

Day 5: Beth Shean, Jacob's Well, Bethlehem, Shepherd's Field

We leave Galilee and head south to the archeological site of Beth Shean, then to Nablus and Jacob's Well. We end our day in Bethlehem at Shepherd's Field and the Church of the Nativity. New Year's Eve celebration, dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 6: Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Western Wall, Jerusalem

In the morning we visit the Mt of Olives to walk the Palm Sunday path to the Garden of Gethsemane. In the afternoon, we visit Jerusalem's Old City, Church of the Holy Sepulchre and the Temple Mount, and we end our day at the Garden Tomb for worship. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 7: Masada, En Gedi, Wadi Qelt, Jordan River, Jericho

We visit the mountain fortress of Masada, then the green oasis of En Gedi associated with King David. On our way to Jerusalem, we will see the fifth-century St. George's Monastery built into the cliffs of Wadi Qelt and enjoy a "Genesis welcome" on Mount Scopus as we come into the Holy City. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.



Holy Land Only Pilgrimage continues

Day 8: Abu Gosh, Emmaus, Jerusalem

We say farewell to our friends who will continue to Jordan as we explore a few more sites around Jerusalem. We will visit the Shrine of the Book and a model of Jerusalem, Abu Gosh and the Church of Visitation, and Emmaus. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 9: Holy Land: Jerusalem

Today we explore the City of David and Pool of Siloam followed by the southern excavations of the Temple Mount. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 10: Holy Land: Return Home

Today we say farewell to the Holy Land and return home.

Day 8: Jordan Extension

We say farewell to our Holy Land friends as we continue to Jordan by crossing the Allenby Bridge then on to the Baptismal Site on the Jordanian side. Dinner and overnight in Wadi Musa.

Day 9: Petra

Today we visit the stunning ancient Edomite and Nabatean capital of Petra, called "the rose-red city half as old as time." Dinner and overnight in Wadi Musa.

Day 10: Madaba, Mt. Nebo, Amman

We will visit Madaba and continue to Mt. Nebo, from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

Day 11: Jerash

This day is devoted to touring the ancient ruins of Jerash. Dinner and overnight in Amman

Day 12: Amman/USA

Transfer to the airport for our flight home.
