RAIH raises money to build houses through this Walkathon and other fundraisers, and through congregation and business donations. We recruit volunteers who spend ten Saturdays building a house, which is presented to the recipient at a dedication celebration at the end of the build.

The families who receive these homes are proud to achieve their dream of home ownership and, in return, pass this sense of pride to others in their community.

Dallas Area Habitat for Humanity

Dallas Area Habitat for Humanity, a major local affiliate for Habitat for Humanity International, was founded in 1985. Dallas Habitat seeks to provide a long-term, permanent solution to the need for decent affordable homes for low-income families. Through donated supplies and volunteer efforts, Dallas Habitat coordinates the construction of new homes in neighborhood groups, and the rehabilitation of existing homes.

With the many volunteers donating both time and materials, Dallas Habitat homes can quickly be built for the equivalent of half the market value. When homes are completed, potential homeowners who have worked on their plan of home ownership with Dallas Habitat are offered a 0% interest mortgage. Potential homeowners must provide at least 300 hours of 'sweat equity' either on their own home or other Habitat projects in lieu of a down-payment.

Dallas Habitat raises its own construction and operating funds for programs. It provides family counseling and education through various courses, workshops and family resource programs. It also encourages the development of Neighborhood Associations to help build a strong neighborhood base.
