

## FAQs

### Where do I register?

Registration is available at [getweird.org](http://getweird.org). Registrations are not confirmed until a deposit is received. *Deposits are non-refundable/non-transferable.*

### When will I receive more details for the trips?

Packing lists and itineraries will be posted online about two weeks prior to the trip.

### What if I need to cancel my registration?

Cancellation for a weekend retreat must be made two weeks before the date of the trip to receive a refund less the deposit. Cancellations for major trips must be made one month before the date of the trip to receive a refund less the deposit. Your youth's expenses are paid in advance by FUMCR, and we are committed to the number reserved after these cancellation deadlines. Balances are due in full by the due date to retain your youth's registration.

### What if I am unable to afford the trip costs?

We believe all youth should have the opportunity to experience the fellowship and service of retreats and trips. Scholarships and need based financial assistance are available for youth retreats and mission trips. They will be held confidential.
